




Reflections from the Deacon's Desk!

What comes to mind when you think of the word love?

-Take a second to reflect on any memories, words, or images that you associate with love. Do your memories agree with the Bible? The Bible has many verses about love. Here are a couple of examples: "Love is patient and kind" (1 Corinthians 13:4); Love is not irritable or resentful" (1 Corinthians 13:5). These examples of love may not agree with the secular definitions of love. We can easily get distracted by romantic movies or other worldly definitions of love, but we are challenged not to be overly influenced. Love is so much more than an emotion. The love of God was made apparent to us in this way: that God sent his only-begotten Son into the world, so that we might live through him (1 John 4:9). God's love is not simply an emotion, idea, or feeling. God's love is real. In showing God's love, we are called to take up our cross and follow Jesus daily. We are called to consider others more significant than ourselves. We are called to present our bodies as a living sacrifice. In other words, we must give our time, our energy, our thoughts, our emotions, and our treasures to others.

·God's love is seen in each of us, God's love is seen in our church as we grow in love, support, and ministry. just as Jesus laid down his life for his sheep, let us also lose our lives for the sake of the gospel. And let our love be made manifest. Let it always point to the love of Jesus that was made manifest in both His life and death for mankind. Amen.
