

Food for thought from Fr. Mekonnen



WHY SHOULD WE HAVE A RELATIONSHOP WITH OUR GURADIAN ANGEL?

God created a Guardian Angel for every human being on earth. God created billions of Angels in one instance, and He asked them to make their choice of whether to serve each person as our Guardian Angel or not. If our guardian Angel said yes, then they immediately experience the beatific vision, which means they would behold the face of God in heaven; if they rejected us, then they became a demon. Satan would then assign that demon to attack us with temptations to disobey God's commandments, because they hate us. If our first Guardian Angel accepts us, then Satan would assign another demon to attack us. The first act of our Guardian Angel is to accept us. It is an act of love, in which they choose to serve us from the moment we are born. Our mothers' Guardian Angel would protect us until we were born. The mission of our Guardian Angel is to protect us from both physical and spiritual harm. (Matthew 4:11) Our Guardian Angel is eager to serve us faithfully, but he cannot force his service on anyone who rejects his helping hand.

It is important to know that the Church teaches us not to name our Guardian Angel or ask to know his name. If we name him, then it is a sign of our authority over him which is false; since only God has authority over them, and by extension our Lady as well. Conversely, if we ask to know his name, then the demon may trick us so that we have no way of being certain if that is his name, or not. It is wise and safe to just call him Guardian Angel and he knows we are speaking to him.
