

## Why Pray?

I read a fable about an unhatched eagle's egg that had been placed with barnyard chickens' eggs to be hatched. The egg hatched and inevitably lived its life just like a chicken. It would scratch the ground for grubs or worms and flutter its wings to fly for a few seconds at a time. One day, an adult eagle flew over the barnyard and the young eagle asked a chicken, "What type of animal is that?," The chicken responded, "That is a graceful, powerful, majestic eagle, but don't worry yourself about that because, it is impossible for you to fly like that." So, the young eagle became old and then died believing it was a chicken.

Prayer is the way God reveals to us our identity in relation to Him because, He created us to have an elevated understanding of our dignity as a beloved adopted son or daughter of God; He created us in his own image. Baptism is the Sacrament that transforms us from a chicken that is unable to fly, into an eagle that has the ability to sore high into the heavenly sky. The secular world discourages us from relating our self to the reality, which is God Himself, because God is hated and rejected by the evil spirit of this world. Nevertheless, we are in tune with reality, as far as, we are in tune with Jesus Christ, who is, " The Way, the Truth and the Life." It is true that sometimes when we pray, we see ourselves as helpless chickens thinking about receiving blessings from God that will help us only to survive, but not thrive into a life of holiness. Perhaps, we do not think that our prayers will be powerful and majestic like an eagle flying over the storms of life, because of our past experiences with prayer. However, The Holy Spirit gives us the power to pray with reverence, love, and attention. The Blessed Virgin was overshadowed by the Holy Spirit and so she prayed with power through the grace of the Holy Spirit. The crosses we receive and bear with the intersession of our Blessed Mother will help our soul to fly over the tempest of our temptations that lead us to sin. If only we deny our self, pick up our crosses and follow Jesus by way of our Lady, then we can see Jesus living in us. Our Lady sees Jesus in us by virtue of our Baptism and confirmation. This is why praying the Gospel through the Holy Rosary becomes a powerful means to help us realize our true worth and accept it as reality. A reality in which is unhatched from within because of the Spirit of God who empowers us to see not only our shortcomings, but also our potential in Christ Jesus because of His infinite mercy and love of our Heavenly Father. Seeking God in prayer is a necessary part of growing faith in our hearts. It is God who gives the increase to the sown seed. God is the one who turns seed into harvest. Prayer is the vehicle!
