





Food for thought with Fr. Mekonnen





Why have a Eucharistic Revival?

Their was a man named S.C. who had a list of serious health issues because he didnt live a healthy life style and all of a sudden, he ran out of money to pay for his health insurance. He proceeded to pray with trust in our Heavenly Father's mercy through Jesus Christ in the Holy Spirit through the most Holy rosary. Then he heard that one of his relatives passed away and had left him a huge inheritance. S.C. used all of it to pay for the best doctors in the world. He thought to himself, "I am sure since I have all this money I will find a shortcut to getting my body healthy again with little or no effort." S.C. told the first doctor "look, I don't want to have any surgeries and therapy." He listened to all the specialists one after another and they all gave him the same advice, which was, "You will need surgery and therapy." He finally caves in to have the surgery, but he insists that therapy isn't necessary. The world renown doctor with a perfect record named J.C. tells S.C. "look there are no shortcuts, so you need both surgery and therapy afterwards. Your body was created by God and even science obeys the laws of God, hence that is why we have to study it, so that we can use its principles to bring about the outcome we would to see. The choice is yours, but you need to eat healthy and start exercising otherwise, you will not live a long life."

I bring up this parable as way to help us see with eyes of faith what God sees whenever He looks at us, His beloved children. Both the relative that passed away and left S.C. a great inheritance and the doctor J.C. is Jesus Christ. Jesus is both the Sacrificial Lamb and the Divine Doctor. Jesus does surgery whenever we go to confession, and that is why I wanted to be available to hear confessions for three hours three days in a row. I know that the good Lord wants to remove the disease of serious sin, so that our soul gets a new beginning. The Blood of Jesus is the powerful medicine for the soul and the body. The therapy is doing the penance which is praying, carrying our cross, and fasting. The therapy is also praying in a posture that is sacrificial in nature such as, praying in adoration on our knees, standing or sitting in an atatmosphere of silence. I believe Jesus is the Way, we must follow Him, so we follow Him into the desert in which He prayed in total silence. It is true that our physical body hungers and thirsts for food, but that food has to be nutritious in order for us to be healthy. Our soul is integrated with our body and, so we hunger to receive our Blessed Lord in the most Holy Eucharist. I offered up the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass three evenings, so that our faith in Jesus becomes strong and active like that of Saints in heaven. This living out our Catholic faith which gives us the strength to overcome temptations to seek shortcuts that undermine our call to be in Communion with the Holy Trinity and each other.
