

Lectio Divina ongomg reflection

READ SLOWLY the following Scripture two or three times.

Many of Jesus' disciples who were listening said,"This saying is hard; who can accept it?" Since Jesus knew that his disciples were murmuring about this, he said to them, "Does this shock you? What if you were to see the Son of Man ascending to where he was before? It is the spirit that gives life, while the flesh is of no avail. The words I have spoken to you are Spirit and life. But there are some of you who do not believe." Jesus knew from the beginning the ones who would not believe and the one who would betray him. And he said, "For this reason I have told you that no one can come to me unless it is granted him by my Father." As a result of this, many of his disciples returned to their former way of life and no longer accompanied him. Jesus then said to the Twelve, "Do you also want to leave?" Simon Peter answered him, "Master, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life. We have come to believe and are convinced that you are the Holy One of God." (John 6:60-69)

MEDITATION After the reading, take some time to reflect in silence on one or more of the following questions:

- What word or words in this passage caught your attention?
- What in this passage comforted you?
- What in this passage challenged you?

CONTEMPLATION

What conversion of mind, heart, and life is the Lord asking of me? "What if you were to see the Son of Man ascending to where he was before? When have I felt confirmed in my faith? When have I felt God's presence most strongly? The words I have spoken to you are Spirit and life." What Scripture passages do I turn to when I need inspiration? What Scripture passages do I turn to when I need to feel closer to God? "For this reason, I have told you that no one can come to me unless it is granted him by my Father." How do I show my gratitude for the gift of faith?

How can I help others come to the Father?

JOURNAL

Write out all your answers so that you can fully understand what the Holy Spirit is saying to you personally, and the response you give back to Him. Lectio Divina is not a monologue, but rather a dialogue between you and God.

CHALLANGE

How can I make my life a gift for others in charity? Read and pray with Scripture for 15 minutes a day each day this week.
